The City of North Tonawanda Becomes First Niagara County Municipality to Approve the Niagara River Greenway Plan

Resolutions of approval from the City of Tonawanda & Town of Grand Island also pass

Grand Island, NY, February 7, 2007...The Niagara River Greenway Commission (NRGC) announces the first Niagara County municipality to approve the Niagara River Greenway Plan as the City of North Tonawanda. On Tuesday, February 6th, both the City of North Tonawanda and the City of Tonawanda passed resolutions to unanimously approve their support of the plan as submitted by the NRGC. On Monday night, the Town of Grand Island unanimously passed a resolution to approve supporting the plan.

The three municipalities join the Town of Tonawanda, which approved its support of the plan on January 24th.

The Commission, established by law in 2004, will aid in the planning and development of a greenway of interconnected parks, river access points and waterfront trails along the Niagara River from Lake Erie at Buffalo to Lake Ontario at the site of the historic Fort Niagara.
