## **The Towns of Porter & Wheatfield Approve the Niagara River Greenway Plan**

Grand Island, NY, March 13, 2007...The Niagara River Greenway Commission (NRGC) announces that the Town of Porter and Town of Wheatfield are the third and fourth Niagara County municipality to approve the Niagara River Greenway Plan. On Monday, March 12th, the Towns passed a resolution, unanimously approving their support of the plan as submitted by the NRGC.

The Towns of Porter and Wheatfield become the seventh and eighth municipalities, to approve the plan. They join the Villages of Kenmore and Youngstown, Towns of Tonawanda and Grand Island and the Cities of North Tonawanda and Tonawanda. The Commission, established by law in 2004, will aid in the planning and development of a greenway of interconnected parks, river access points and waterfront trails along the Niagara River from Lake Erie at Buffalo to Lake Ontario at the site of the historic Fort Niagara.
